Thank you for your submitted request for monitoring on Milltown Creek and Dog Branch. DEQ's Northern Regional Office has reviewed your request. We are happy to let you know that DEQ will likely be able to accommodate ambient monitoring on each of the streams in 2019. While monitoring site selection has not yet been finalized, we anticipate that the Dog Branch site may be located at the Rt. 630 crossing into Loudoun County, and the Milltown Creek site at the bridge near Rt. 673.

DEQ appreciates your nomination. The citizen nomination process is an important resource to help DEQ identify water bodies for sampling. DEQ makes every effort to have monitoring data available to the public.
